

Full Year Participation Scoring Example: MIPS Transition Year (2017)

- Practice size: 1 MIPS eligible clinician
- Practice type: Primary Care
- EHR Certification: 2014
- Panel of patients: 2,800
- Participating in TCPI through SNE-PTN
- All quality measures will have benchmarks
- Quality measures will be submitted through a registry and qualify as end-to-end electronic submissions

Assumptions

- Quality Performance Category: report a minimum of 6 quality measures
- Advancing Care Information Performance Category: report at least the required advancing care information measures
- Improvement Activities Performance Category: report up to 2 improvement activities (small practices)
- Time frame: Calendar year 2017

** To calculate the Performance Score divide the numerator by the denominator, this will give you the performance rate for a specific measure. Cross reference the calculated performance rate with the table to the left to determine your percentage score.

Example: $(2200/2500) * 100 = 88$ → A performance rate of 88 gives you the percentage score of 9%

Performance Rates for Each Measure Worth Up to 10%

Performance Rate 1-10 = 1%	Performance Rate 51-60 = 6%
Performance Rate 11-20 = 2%	Performance Rate 61-70 = 7%
Performance Rate 21-30 = 3%	Performance Rate 71-80 = 8%
Performance Rate 31-40 = 4%	Performance Rate 81-90 = 9%
